LEARN TO KNIT :: \$60

Attend four two-hour classes to learn knitting basics.

CONTINENTAL KNITTING CLASS :: \$25

September 23 :: 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. (Saturday)

Learn the Art of Continental Knitting to improve efficiency and increase your knitting speed.

Pre-requisite: Casting on, Knit stitch, purl stitch, yarn over, increases, decreases and binding off.

Materials list: Approximately 100 yds of worsted weight yarn and knitting needles to match your weight of yarn.

WEAVING FOR SCHACHT FLIP LOOMS AND/OR CRICKET LOOMS :: \$45

October 7 :: 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. (Saturday)

Attend a workshop to warp and weave a pillow using a Schacht Flip or Cricket Loom. Bring a snack.

Pre-requisite: none

Materials list: Approximately 200 yds of worsted or DK yarn for weft and approximately 200 yds for warp.
Equipment: Cricket or Flip Loom, two shuttles, threader hook, brown craft paper, foundation weaving book and tape measure.

CROCHET: DECORATIVE EDGES FOR KNITTERS :: \$35

October 21 :: 1 p.m. – 4 p.m. (Saturday)

Ever wish that you could put a decorative edge on a baby blanket or afghan? Learn to embellish your edges with easy crocheted edges.

Pre-requisite: none

Materials list: Crochet H and approximately 100 yards of worsted weight yarn

Homework: Knit three 6" square swatches, one in garter stitch, one stockinette stitch and one in seed stitch.

BASIC TOP DOWN RAGLAN SWEATER WORKSHOP :: \$120

September 16 :: 1 p.m. – 3 p.m., September 30 :: 1 p.m. – 5 p.m. and October 7, 14 and 28 :: 1 p.m. – 3 p.m.

This class is intended for the intermediate confident knitter using your own sweater measurements to knit a top down construction sweater in the gauge that you love.

Bring your yarn to the first session and receive instruction on swatching. Your instructor will teach you the top down sweater formula and guide you through the application of the formula to your personal sweater measurements. The student is responsible for all mathematical work.

Materials list and homework: Yarn for entire sweater based on Stashbot Guide, variety of needles for swatching appropriate for your yarn, notebook and pen/pencil.

Pre-requisite: Knitting in the round, have already knitted a sweater, increases & decreases, cast on & pick up stitches.

Skills used

- Casting on
- Stockinette stitch
- Bind off and pick up stitches
- Increases and decreases

Skills learned

- How to use a gauge swatch to plan your work
- Double decrease
- How to determine the appropriate amount of stitches to pick up in a specific area
- What to do in the future to adjust patterns for fit

Knitting Skills

BRIOCHE: WORSTED BRIOCHE BANDANA COWL BY LAVANYA PATRICELLA :: \$35

October 21 :: 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. (Saturday)

Knit a stylish unisex seamless cowl is knit in the 2 color brioche stitch. The pattern is worked both in the round and flat. It's tapered in the back so it fits nicely around the neck and under the jacket. One size fits most, this is warm and super soft. It measures 24" x 15" from cast on to point.

Pre-requisite: Intermediate knitter who can read patterns and knit in the round using 2 colors and 2 hands

Materials list: 2 Skeins of Tosh Vintage in 2 colorways (1skein MC & 1skein CC), US#8 16" circular needle and Ravelry pattern "Worsted Brioche Cowl"

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Sock Knitting Workshops

TOE-UP SOCKS WORKSHOP :: \$55

September 16 :: 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. and

September 23 :: 9 a.m. – 11 a.m.

Learn to knit a toe-up sock with afterthought heel in two classes.

Pre-requisite: Casting on, knit stitch, purl stitch, binding off and completed knitting a hat in the round.

Materials list: Churchmouse "Simple Toe-Up Sock with Afterthought Heel" pattern, 1 yd of smooth waste yarn, 2 skeins Rowan Felted Tweed yarn or any DK/sport yarn, US #3 double points or US#3 32-inch circular needle.

Homework: No homework for first class. For second class complete placement of afterthought heel with waste yarn and complete the cuff, ready to knit afterthought heel in class. Begin second sock if desired.

CUFF-DOWN SOCKS WORKSHOP :: \$55

November 4 :: 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. and

November 11 :: 9 a.m. – 11 a.m.

Learn to knit a traditional sock from the cuff down to the toe in one class.

Pre-requisite: Casting on, knit stitch, purl stitch, binding off and completed knitting a hat in the round.

Materials list: Churchmouse "Basic Sock" pattern, 2 skeins Rowan Felted Tweed yarn or any DK or sport weight yarn, US #3 double points or US#3 32-inch circular needle.

Homework: For first class knit the cuff in 2x2 rib in desired length for one/two socks. For the second class knit the foot of your sock/socks to the point of beginning decreases.

NATIONAL BREAST CANCER MONTH

Join us in our launch this fall by knitting at open Saturday Knit-ins at the shop or at home beginning on September 30th.

Free patterns are available at the shop and of course beautiful yarns.

Knitted Knockers are special handmade breast prosthesis for women who have undergone mastectomies or other procedures to the breast. Traditional breast prosthetics are usually expensive, heavy, sweaty and uncomfortable. They typically require special bras or camisoles with pockets and can't be worn for weeks after surgery. Knitted Knockers on the other hand are soft, comfortable, beautiful and when placed in a regular bra they take the shape and feel of a real breast. Volunteer knitters provide these free to those requesting them. Knitted knockers can be adjusted to fill the gap for breasts that are uneven and easily adapted for those going through reconstruction by simply removing some of the stuffing.
